Introduction

To ensure a uniform layout, please follow this template when submitting your abstract. Standard text in *Times New Roman* 10pt font. Headings in bold face *Arial* 10pt font. Use single-line spacing and leave a line gap between paragraphs. This helps your text to be read easily. Abstract should be prepared in two column format. **The completed abstract should not exceed one A4 page in length.**

References should be indicated by [reference numbers] in the text and should be numbered in one consecutive series by order of mention in the text with each reference individually numbered.

Abstracts should contain the following sections:

- Introduction
- Results and Discussion
- Conclusion
- References
- Acknowledgements.

Results and Discussion

Results may include standard text, equations, tables, and figures. Equations should be entered using an equation editor where possible as shown below:

$$2jk \frac{\partial u}{\partial x} = e^{-u} \quad (1)$$

Equations should be entered in *Times New Roman* 10 point font size. Equation should be centred with right-justified equation number in parentheses.
